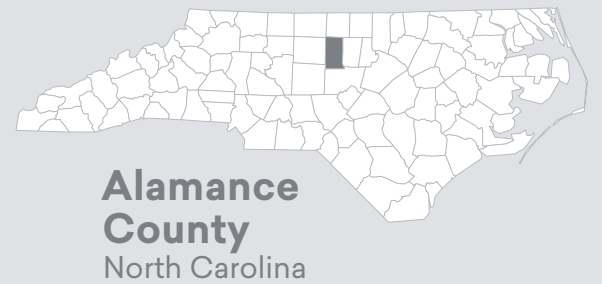

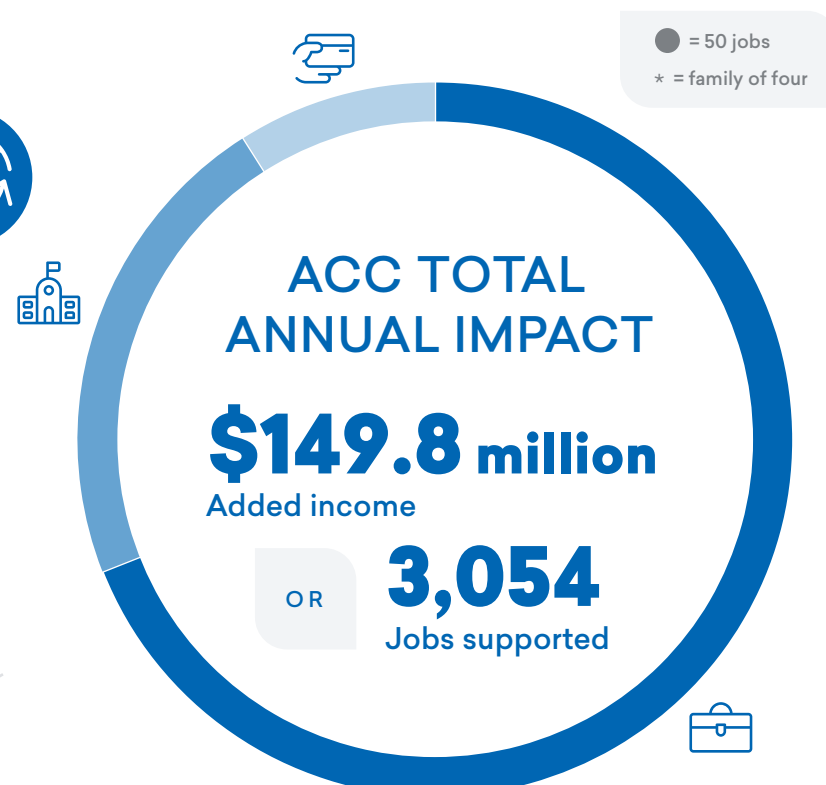

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

For every \$1...

Students gain **\$4.30** in lifetime earnings

Taxpayers gain **\$2.40** in added tax revenue and public sector savings

Society gains **\$8.10** in added state revenue and social savings

The average associate degree graduate from ACC will see an increase in earnings of **\$7,500** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in North Carolina.
