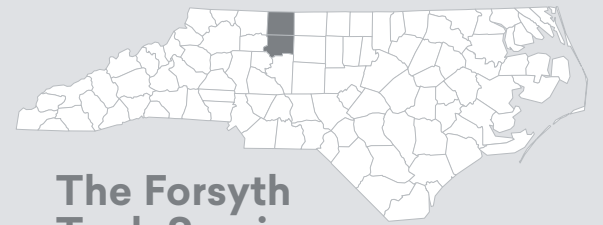

Impact of the increased earnings of Forsyth Tech alumni and the businesses they work for

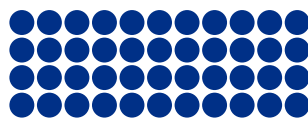

293 Jobs supported



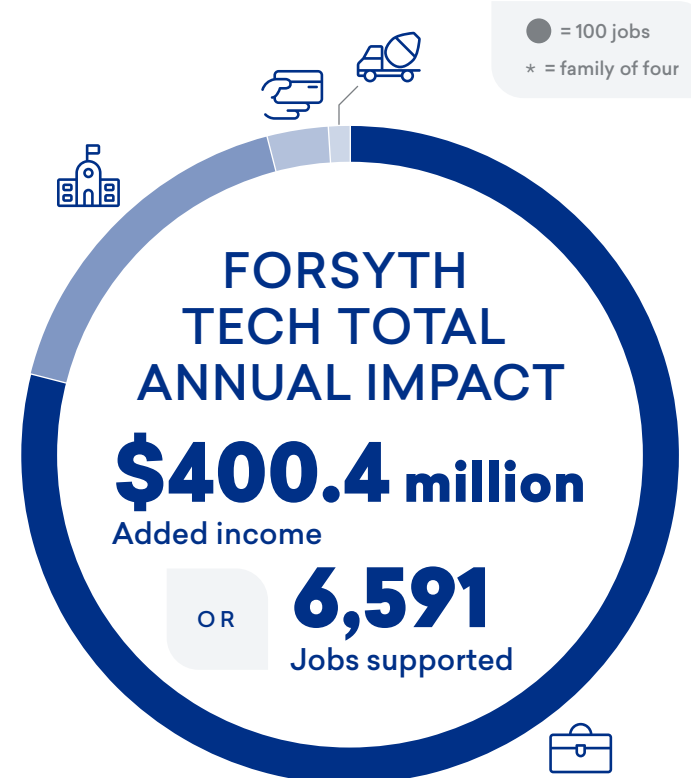
Construction spending impact

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

For every \$1...



Students gain **\$4.50** in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain **\$2.00** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$8.00** in added state revenue and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from Forsyth Tech will see an increase in earnings of **\$8,600** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in North Carolina.
