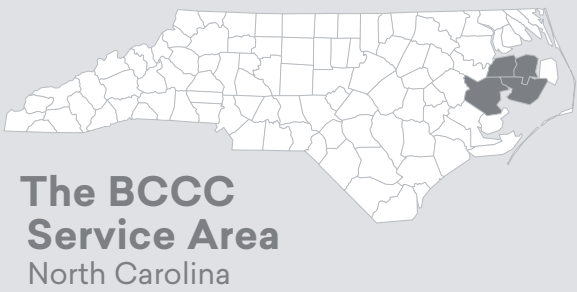

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS



For every \$1...



Students gain \$4.20 in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain \$2.00 in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains \$7.10 in added state revenue and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from BCCC will see an increase in earnings of \$7,300 each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in North Carolina
