INVESTMENT ANALYSIS



For every \$1...



Students gain \$5.20 in lifetime earnings





Taxpayers gain \$1.70 in added tax revenue and public sector savings





Society gains \$8.00 in added state revenue and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from Mitchell will see an increase in earnings of \$8,900 each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in North Carolina.
