

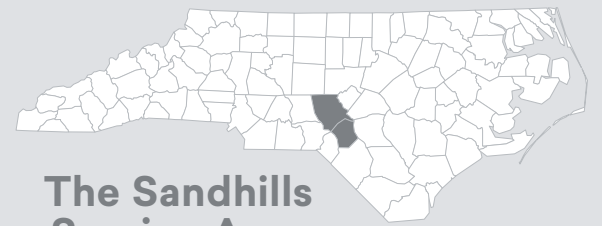

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

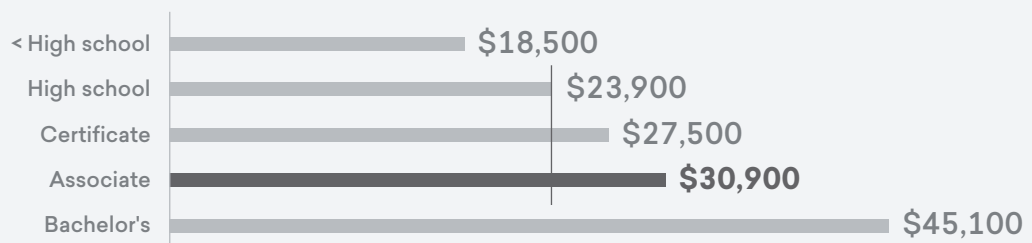
For every \$1...

Students gain **\$6.60** in lifetime earnings

Taxpayers gain **\$1.70** in added tax revenue and public sector savings

Society gains **\$8.40** in added state revenue and social savings

The average associate degree graduate from SCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$7,000** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in North Carolina.
