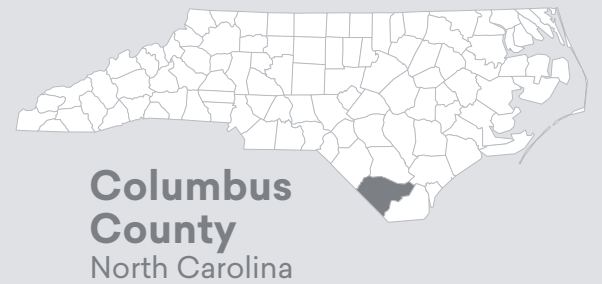

Alumni impact

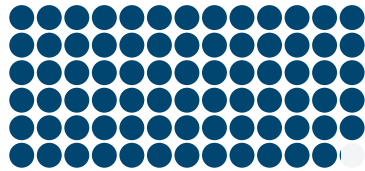
Impact of the increased earnings of SCC alumni and the businesses they work for

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

For every \$1...



Students gain **\$3.80** in lifetime earnings



Taxpayers gain **\$2.40** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$7.00** in added state revenue and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from SCC will see an increase in earnings of **\$6,600** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in North Carolina.
